The Hicks family moved to Detroit, Michigan where Eddie attended Detroit Public Schools. Eddie accepted Christ in his life when he visited Unity Baptist Church and heard the angelic voices of the choir that moved him in such a way he joined the church and was a faithful member until his health started to fail him.

Eddie worked at Chrysler Automotive until his eyesight started to fail and forced him to quit. Eddie found employment at Burns Security and attended Vocational Rehab Program due to his failing eyesight. He met Victoria Reed through the rehab program and they married on September 1, 1990.

Eddie's eyesight continued to diminish until he lost his sight completely. But this was a man of vision. He took his family to Indianapolis, Indiana where he became successfully self-employed and he opened Eddie's Snack Bar, until he retired in 2011 and moved back to Detroit.

Eddie's health continued to diminish until he had a massive stroke in 2018, which left him immobile. Eddie continued to have health issues until he finally relinquished his hold on this world on September 17, 2019.

Eddie loved fishing, listening to music and his books for the visually impaired, visiting with his friends and family, the ID Channel, but most of all Eddie loved being the king of fashion.

Eddie was preceded in death by his parents, Emon and Francis Hicks; his sister, Gladys Hicks; his son, Tony Harris and granddaughter, Jodie Taylor.
