Ethridge Ford, Jr., was born on May 27, 1932 in Lauderdale, Mississippi to parents Ethridge Ford Sr. and Pearlie Ford who preceded him in death. He was the youngest son of 7 children. The family relocated from Mississippi to Michigan in the 1940's, where Ethridge graduated from Northern High School in Detroit, Michigan.

He enlisted into the United States Army where he excelled to the rank of Sargent, he received a Korean Service Ribbon, with two Bronze Campaign Stars, he was in five battles and received a star for each battle. The United States Army greatly appreciate his service.

In 1958, Ethridge met and married Agnes Norris, four children were born to this union.

Ethridge accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal savior later in life.

Ethridge worked as a Master Plumber; Polk's plumbing and Heating, Limbach Mechanical Co., McGuire Mechanical and retired from J.P. Morgan Chase after 43 years of service.

He also owned and operated his own business. He was a lifetime member of The Plumbers Union Local 98, where he received high honors.

Ethridge, affectionally known as "Buck" to all family and friends enjoyed all outdoor activities, he was an avid hunter, fisherman, and loved baseball. He was a member of The Black Panthers AAA baseball club, managed by his brother-in-law Jerry McCallup Sr. He loved to listen to Jazz, you could catch him every year in downtown Detroit at the Jazz festival. He was the Co-President of Century Gun Club, he also was a member since the 1960's. He supported the gun club 100 percent and traveled to different states to promote trap shooting. The trap shoot community will miss him dearly. He also was a fixture at Jordon's Restaurant in Detroit where he enjoyed breakfast and shooting the breeze. He loved his second home (Lakes of The North) in Gaylord, MI, where he enjoyed spending time with his closest friends; Mel, Ed, Herman, Earl, Dillard, Charles, Leon, T.O., Rita, and Richard & Irene Watts.
