MICHAEL RALPH HALL was born in Detroit, Michigan, on September 24, 1944, to Eddie and Corine Hudgens.

As their eldest, his parents entrusted Michael with the responsibility of helping to care for the brood of ten siblings that would follow. The result was a dedication to order, cleanliness, and self-sufficiency that carried him through the rest of his life.

Having accepted Christ at an early age, Michael attended a number of churches, most recently Liberty Temple Baptist. His Christianity was best expressed through his great generosity of spirit. He seemed always ready to give, whether it was food for famished neighbors (or tasty treats for visiting kids), cash for someone just a little short or sage advice for those in need of counsel.

Michael attended the Detroit Public Schools system, graduating from Eastern High School in 1962. An exceptional skill for typing landed him a position with the Detroit office of the Internal Revenue Service right out of high school. Later he was employed by Chrysler Corporation for more than 30 years, working his way up the production line to Quality Control Inspector before retiring at the end of 1998.

Early retirement allowed Michael much more time to pursue his many passions. These included (but certainly were not limited to) bowling; dominoes; cards (spades and whist being his games of choice); weekly bingo games; manning the slot machines at any one of the three Detroit casinos (and on several trips to Las Vegas); and the Michigan Daily Lottery. He avidly followed the local professional and college sports teams such as the Detroit Tigers (often a source of great disappointment), Detroit Lions (an even greater source), Detroit Red Wings, and the football and basketball programs at Michigan State and the University of Michigan. He really loved television; drop-ins invariably found him watching either an old James Bond film (though he did not care for Roger Moore as 007), a Law & Order rerun, that day's installment of The Price is Right or an episode of his absolute favorite sitcom, The Golden Girls.
