Terry D. Craig was born on August 31, 1954 the youngest of three children to Alice Craig and Jimmy Porter of Detroit, Michigan. Terry accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at St. Theresa Catholic Church of Detroit, Michigan. He was also educated in Detroit through various parochial schools as well as The Detroit Public School system which served him well.

At the tender age of 16, Terry cleverly decided to join the United States Military enlisting in the Army and serving across the country and abroad in South Korea. Terry continued his servitude for his country through the United States Army Reserve for the next 14 years with Reserve Unit COD, 2nd Battalion, 330th Regiment and 70th Division as a drill sergeant. Terry was awarded several letters of extraordinary commendations as well as various appreciations for acts of courage during his time served in the military.

As a civilian Terry held several jobs ranging from cable installer, cook, security officer, a lineman at General Motors and eventually landing his career of choice with the City of Detroit through the Water and Sewerage Department. Terry quickly navigated through his career obtaining many positions of greater responsibility during his more than 30 year journey which he was still maintaining at his time of passing.

In 1988, Terry met Lovanier Redden, becoming a beautifully blended family formed with Lovanier's daughters, LaRonda and LaToya and Terry's children, Danean and Rickey as well as Terry Jr., Allison and Lovanier, who were conceived after their wedded union in 1990.

Terry's close family affectionately nicknamed him "Inspector Gadget" due to his fascination and love of technology. Terry was a genius at fixing just about anything and absolutely loved cars and had a favorable pastime of rebuilding computers. He also considered himself a "great cook." But the thing he loved most... and his devotion was held to, his love for his family.
