Aaron Jones was born on July 31, 1927 to Billie Jones and Joanna Dawkins. He was the youngest of 12 children. He graduated from Miller High School.

Aaron was a longstanding and significant member of St. John C.M.E. Church in Detroit. He and his brothers, also known as, The Jones Brothers (James, Monroe, J.B., Vangie, Moses), dedicated their time, money and skills to St. John. Aaron was a member of the A.W. Male Chorus. He also helped out with the Chancel Choirs 1 & 2. He, along with his brother Vangie purchased the organ and piano in the Chapel and the speakers for the hammond organ in the sanctuary.

Aaron was a member of the US Army and served in Korea during his tour. He worked, for several years, at Davis Cute Rate Drugs in Detroit. He later retired from the Detroit Institute of Arts. Aaron was a Leo and had many lion themed items, such as jewelry and linens. He was a very snazzy dresser. Always looking good in his suits and casual clothes.

Although Aaron never married or had children of his own, he loved and was very close to his siblings. He loved his family and has left behind nieces, nephews and friends who loved him and will cherish his memory.
