Alberta Walker was born on October 4, 1934 in Uniontown, Alabama to Bessie L. McCreary and Charlie Walker. Alberta accepted Christ at an early age prior to moving to Michigan in 1953. Alberta attended the Perry County Schools in Alabama. At a young age Alberta excelled in music by displaying a gift for piano playing. She first learned to play by ear and then took formal lessons to learn to read music. Later, Alberta continued to perfect her talent for music by learning to play a number of instruments. She played the French horn in her high school band. She also became a regular pianist for her church and numerous family weddings throughout the years. She also sang in the choir for her home church (St. Paul AME Zion).

Alberta's talent went beyond her love for music as she was Valedictorian of her graduating high school class, something which she never spoke of. After high school Alberta took some college business classes. Upon arrival to Michigan, Alberta worked at a local dress shop on "The Avenue of Fashion." She later became a claims adjuster for AAA of Michigan, where she continued to work for over 20 years. While at AAA, Alberta sang in the choir. Alberta enjoyed watching basketball, football, game shows, and a few of the detective shows, especially Colombo. Most of all, she enjoyed baking, particularly caramel cake, coconut cake and homemade rolls. Some of her favorite things to do included, shopping, and catalog ordering; so much so, she was on a first

name basis with her mailman and UPS driver. Her children's fondest memories were listening to Alberta play Christmas and Easter songs faithfully during each holiday, and waking up on Sunday mornings to the sounds of James Cleveland and Aretha Franklin.
