Angela (Angie) Gail Wynn was born on November 30, 1957 in Detroit, Michigan to the union of the late Helen Ella and George Washington Wynn.

She attended Courville Elementary School, Nolan Jr. High School and proudly graduated from Cass Technical High School.

Home during her formative years was at 17880 (or seventeen eight eighty as it was lovingly referred to by the family) Goddard, Detroit, MI.

On April 30, 2007 Wayne State University issued the following: To all who read these letters, Greetings, The Honorary Board of Regents and the Board of Directors of The National Society of Collegiate Scholars confer honor and distinction upon Angela G. Wynn for commitment to the ideal of Scholarship, Leadership and Service. On May 7, 2012, honor student Angela G. Wynn earned and proudly accepted from Wayne State University, a Bachelor of Arts Degree and graduating at the top of her class did so with the distinction of Magna Cum Laude.

Angela accepted Christ at an early age and became a member of Corinthian Missionary Baptist Church where her grandparents were founding members.

She and her family were dedicated and faithful members and later were members of Christ Cornerstone Missionary Baptist Church where Rev. Obie Mathews was the pastor. As a teen and into adulthood, Angie served on the young ushers board, sang in Corinthian's children's choir The Sunbeams and onto the Wesley Memorial Choir, Inspirational Choir and Comilla G. Ensemble Choirs at Christ Cornerstone MBC.

Angela was employed with Greektown Casino as an Auditor and loved talking about her job and the work she did. In addition to her biological family, Angela loved and was well loved by her extended family...her Greektown Casino co-workers.

Angela had many passions but her biggest one was photography. She started her company Photograph's by Angela in 1980. In the early days of her photography career, some of her photos hung on the walls of Henry Ford Hospital on E. Grand Blvd. in Detroit. During the mid-eighties, she lived for a short time in Anchorage, Alaska where her work could be found in hospitals, doctor's offices, businesses and churches. Angela could talk about any subject, but if you wanted to see her eyes sparkle all you had to do was mention baseball. She and her dad were frequent visitors to Tiger Stadium when it was located on Trumbull St. in Detroit.

On September 7, 2013 at 11:45 a.m., Angela departed this earthly life and was greeted at the gates of Heaven by her parents, Helen and George Wynn who preceded her in death.

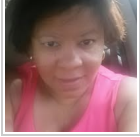

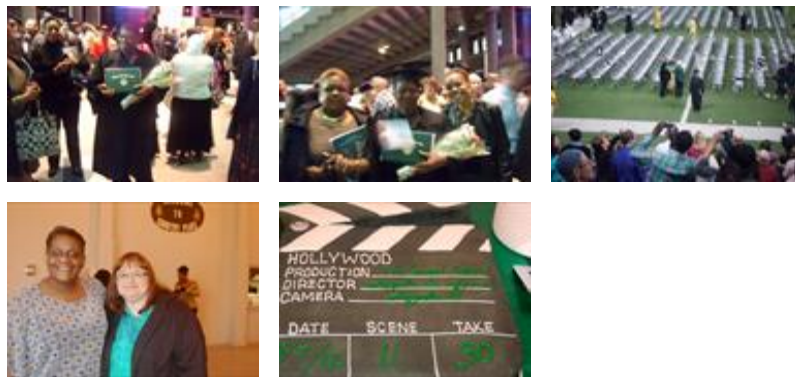
