Annie Mae and Ann Marie were members of the famed "Lucille Lemons Gospel Singers," where mom would meet Mom Winans as well.

Ann Marie attended and graduated from Northwestern High School, where she was on the field-hockey team. Ann Marie loved sewing for friends and family. Ann Marie took an interest in real estate.

Ann Marie was employed with General Motors for 40 years, worked her way up to Quality Control. She retired in 2004.

In 1953, Ann Marie was joined in holy matrimony with Reginald (Red) Smith, to this union one child was born. In 1955, Ann Marie was joined in holy matrimony again with Thomas James Lewis. To this union four children were born.

Ann Marie would master the piano and become a choir director for Jeffries Baptist Church until the end.
