Anthony Juan Carter was born on March 21, 1968 in Detroit, Michigan, to Florence Carter and Freeman Andrews, Sr. and was loved as an adopted son by Craig Carter (they preceded him in death). Anthony accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Peace Baptist Church, Rev. Dr. Stacy Williams, Pastor.

Anthony was a Detroit Public Schools student. While attending Cody High, Anthony learned auto mechanics from his brother Steve Carter. Soon after, he would assist in car repairs and became the proud owner of a Trans Am. A few years later, attributed to his diabetic condition, Anthony lost his sight and enrolled in Continuing Education School for the Blind.

He loved reading, particularly spiritual books, and frequently visited the library. Of all his hobbies, Anthony was a talented drum and bongo player. He frequently visited Third New Hope Missionary Baptist Church and played bongos with the band.

He faithfully participated in the Meditation Outreach Program where he was a duet singer and played the drums in the band for the seeing impaired. He sang his favorite song "The Question Is," as a member of Echos of Praise

Inspirational Choir, Lovevise Green, Founder and Director. He also played drums at Star of Zion Missionary Baptist Church.

He loved to dance and often taught his nieces and nephews the latest dance moves. He was also an avid blackjack player.

Later in life, Anthony became a founding member of Nehemiah Baptist Church, Detroit, MI and acknowledged a call to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Anthony had many dedicated caregivers who participated in his care on a weekly basis, aside from his siblings, nieces and nephews: Ann Livingston, Dave Lee, William and Wontaz Bynum (brothers). His doctors and nurses attest without a doubt that the care he received prolonged his life.
