April Elaine Burton was born in Detroit, MI on May 17, 1954 to the union of Herbert Burton and Alice Burton, who both preceded her in death. She was the fourth of seven children and the second eldest daughter.

Her spiritual life began at an early age with her family at Greater Love Tabernacle, Church of God in Christ, where she was taught to trust, serve and live for the Lord.

April was educated in the Detroit Public School system, receiving a diploma from David Mackenzie High School in 1972. She went on to further her education by pursuing an Accounting degree at Lewis College of Business.

She began a successful 30-year banking career at Detroit Bank & Trust, which is now Comerica Bank. Her strong mathematical skills played a key role in her advancement from Accounting Clerk to Investment Associate.

April was not only a hard worker, but she was also a devoted mother. In 1975, she gave birth to a daughter that she raised as a single mother. However, this would not last for long. In 1983, she was united in marriage to Aubrey Carvine and to that union a son was born.

In addition to raising her children, she enjoyed: dancing, going to the casino,

weekend excursions with her daughter, British drama series, holidays with family and conversing with her big sister. But her greatest joy was spending time with her grandchildren.
