Ashaki Nalango Rives was born on November 25, 1970 to the union of Armadale and Andrew Rives Sr. in Detroit, Michigan. Ashaki attended Detroit Public Schools and graduated with honors from Central High School in 1988. She also attended Oakland University pursuing her degree in Elementary Education. Ashaki loved helping others and therefore was employed through various Human Services agencies, including Orchards Human Services.

Ashaki accepted Christ at a very early age. She was baptized at Tennessee Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Harry Nelson Napoleon. She later became a member of Jamison Temple Missionary Baptist Church serving under the leadership of Pastor Homer Jamison. As a child she served faithfully singing in the Joy Bells Choir and on the Youth Usher Board. As an adult she was a member of the Praise Team and the Intercessors. 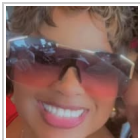
