Beatrice Lander was born on March 29, 1952 to her loving parents, Mother Darnell Stubblefield and Father Lucian Lander, in Paducah, Kentucky. At an early age, Beatrice gave her life to Christ where she attended St. John Missionary Baptist Church. As a little girl, she studied basic education at Monroe Grammal, later graduating from Newburgh High School, preparing her for the next steps in life.

In the mid 70's, Beatrice packed up and relocated to Detroit, Michigan with her two sons. Over a few years, while maintaining work and raising her sons, Beatrice gave birth to two daughters. Working multiple jobs, raising kids, and obtaining her bachelor's and Master's in science at Wayne state University she realized it was more to life and chose to enlist in the U.S. Army to ensure a better life for her family.

After being honorably discharged as Lieutenant from the Army in the late 80s, Beatrice began her journey as a mail carrier with the United States Postal Service. Over a few years, she gave birth to two other daughters. She

continued her career at the postal service, gaining and accelerating from supervisor and then to Manager of her own station in which she loved her job and had a lifelong journey with her career at the USPS for 39 long hardworking years.
