Shortly after graduating from trade school, Bernard began to work at Hudson's Department Store, later known as Marshall Field's and now known as Macy's. Bernard was a faithful employee for 33 years. He was loved and well respected by all of his co-workers and customers during the time he was there.

Bernard accepted Christ as his personal savior at an early age and joined Holy Cross Missionary Baptist Church in the early 70's, under the pastorate of Rev. James H. Porter. Through encouragement and spiritual guidance, Bernard accepted a position as Trustee and remained in that position until his death. In addition to being a Trustee he was appointed Chaplin of the Inspirational Choir.
