The Life and Legacy of Betty L. Moore:

Betty Lou Moore was born on March 24, 1948 in Stamps, Arkansas. She was the second of three children born to the union of John B. Miller, Sr. and Louise Kendrick Miller. Betty attended the Stamps Public Schools and graduated from Ellis High School. She attended A.M. & N. College in Pine Bluff, Arkansas.

Betty accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior at an early age and was baptized at the Brown's Chapel C.M.E. Church in Stamps, Arkansas.

Betty moved to Detroit in 1967 and worked at Awrey Bakery for the Summer, where she met Cleveland Moore. After moving back to Arkansas, she corresponded with Cleveland, and after two years, they married on September 28, 1969 in Stamps, Arkansas. Two children were born to this union, Toya Monique and Christal DE Vonne.

After moving to Detroit, Betty worked for the State of Michigan as a Key Punch Operator; and, became a member of Saint Stephens African Methodist Episcopal Church and served as a Stewardess until her health failed. She later became a member of Truth Missionary Baptist Church, under the pastorate of Rev. Thomas L. Moore.

Betty was a loving and devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and sister. She enjoyed cooking and caring for her family and home. Even as her health failed, she still managed to do all she could in her home; making certain, her family was filled with love, peace, comfort, and joy.

Betty first became ill in 2000 and persevered through many challenges and setbacks. On Saturday, April 14, 2018, she heard the call of her Lord and departed this life, in Vibra-Beaumont Hospital.
