### The Life Of Bettye Jean Hall:

Born in Terre Haute, Indiana, Bettye was the only child of Alice and Harry G. Smith. She graduated from Saginaw High School and then attended Los Angeles City College. While attending college, she joined First AME Church in Los Angeles. Upon her return to Saginaw, her membership was transferred to Bethel AME, where she served as a Sunday school teacher, associate member of the senior choir and a charter member of the Bowman Gospel Chorus.

She was united in matrimony with Willie Jay Hall on October 30, 1954. The family moved to Detroit in 1959, and united with St. Andrew AME Church, where Bettye served faithfully as Sunday school teacher, superintendent, senior choir member, steward, associate member of the Choralaires, lay reader, missionary and a charter member of the Friends of Ed. Scholarship Committee. She loved music and was an active member the 4th District Conference Choir.

Bettye worked for Newman's in Saginaw, National Bank of Detroit, Supreme Life Insurance and the City of Detroit Health Department, for 23 years at Bruce Douglas Health Center.
