Beverly Jean Miller was born on September 26, 1940 in Detroit, MI. She was the oldest of seven children born to the late Charlie Pearl Thomas and John C. Miller. Beverly had six siblings, one sister Twanda, and five brothers that preceded her in death: Bruce, Mansfield (Buck), Sedrick (Pug), Wayne (Moe), Charles Jr (Skeet).

At an early age Beverly accepted Jesus Christ and she made sure her children were baptized. She was a faithful member of Unity Baptist Church for over 30 years, she served on the Usher Board until her health prevented her from serving.

Beverly graduated from Wilbur Wright High School in 1959. While attending high school she volunteered for the service club which explains her willingness to help others. After high school Beverly worked for General Motors, retiring after 30 years. She called it "Generous Motors, she was a member of U.A.W. Local 909.

In 1980 Beverly became a member of the Order of the Eastern Star. She earned the following degrees: Eastern Star, Queen of South Degree, and Amaranth Degree. She served as Worthy Matron of Priscilla Chapter #21 Order of the Eastern Star Prince Hall Affiliated Jurisdiction of Michigan in 1986. In 1994 she joined the Daughters of Isis. She was a member of

Ceremonial Team #2, the Ladies Drill Team and she served as a Honorary Past Commandress.

Beverly had a strong love for her family, with emphasis on protection and caring. She had a fun and loving spirit that touched everyone who knew her. She had an unconditional love for those who entered her life.

After a lengthy battle with illness Beverly made her transition on August 30, 2014.
