Bonnie Jean Clark was born Sept 20, 1951 in Somerville, Tennessee. She was the only child of Bertha Mae Clark-Hinton and John T. Hinton, who preceded her in death. Bonnie and her family moved to Detroit, Michigan where she attended Detroit Public Schools and graduated from Mackenzie High School.

In 1972, Bonnie married Richard S. Ingram and together they raised two wonderful sons, Kevin and Terrell. Bonnie began her career at Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan where she held various positions. She rose through the ranks at Blue Cross until she retired as a Corporate Trainer in 2009, after 39 years of service. After her retirement, Bonnie worked at the Detroit Area Agency on Aging and volunteered to deliver Meals on Wheels to area seniors. These are just a few examples of the numerous community, civic and outreach projects that she worked on.

Bonnie was born again at New Way Christian Community Church, under the ministry leadership of Pastor Henry Cooper. While at New Way she served in the choir and on the missionary board. As head of the missionary board she started a women's outreach ministry at the original Genesis House through the Detroit Rescue Mission. She also initiated clothing and food drives to support those in need.

In 1994, Bonnie joined the Dunamis Outreach Ministries, under the ministry leadership of Pastor Reginald M. Lane. During her years at Dunamis, she served faithfully on many auxiliaries. She served on the tape ministry, intercessory prayer ministry and was one of the leaders of the hospitality ministry. She was also an integral member of the Women of Power staff, working with Pastor Kelly Lane. Bonnie's heart was inclined to serve people and she would help anyone who had a need.

Bonnie was kind and giving. She loved God. She shared that love with others as a testimony to her determination to be more like Him.
