Brad Johnson, Sr., was born November 18, 1924 in Mansfield, Louisiana to the late William Johnson and Hattie Grant Johnson. Brad was the eldest of four children.

Brad accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized.

Brad's formal education began at Desoto Parrish Training School and the Louisiana State Approved Negro High School in Mansfield, Louisiana where he earned his High School diploma on May 22, 1944. He went on to further that education at Texas College in Tyler, Texas where he majored in Mathematics and earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Education on May 18, 1953. He continued his love for math by taking post graduate courses in mathematics in pursuit of a master's degree. He received many accolades for his high level of mathematical prowess.

Brad was a Veteran of the United States Army and proudly served his country in World War II; where he earned a Victory Medal before being honorably discharged on February 2, 1946.

Brad was joined in holy matrimony for nearly 60 years to his soul-mate and love of his life Johnnie Mae Campbell on December 20, 1955. To this union four children were born; Brad, Jr., William, Deborah, and James Greg.

Brad was employed by Detroit Public Schools as a math teacher for a number of years and later worked at McCloud Steel until his retirement. During his working life and after his retirement, he utilized his entrepreneurial skills to open and operate several successful businesses; he was the owner and operator of Johnson Realty Company, Johnson Tax Services and Johnson Produce where he provided fruits, vegetable and fresh fish for the community.

Brad made his transition from 93 wonderful years of Earthly life to his Eternal rest on Wednesday, February 7, 2018.
