The Life Of Callie Mae Brown:

Callie was born on April 2, 1933 in Troy, Alabama to Victoria Jackson and Jimmie Fuller, who both preceded her in death.

Callie accepted Christ at the age of ten. She was baptized in a creek in Goshen, Alabama. As the eldest of ten children, she set the precedents for her younger siblings.

In 1947, at an early age, she married James Autrey in Alabama. This union was blessed with four beautiful children. The family moved to the Detroit area of Michigan in the mid-1950s.

Sometime in the late 1950s, after separating from James, Callie was united in holy matrimony to her second spouse, George Brown, Jr., who preceded her in death in February, 1993. To this blessed union birthed three wonderful children.

Being the loving, giving, nurturing, caring, kind-spirited and feisty woman she was, Callie worked tirelessly in the nursing arena. She was a nurses aide for well over 25 years. Always feeling the need to help others, she worked in nursing facilities with elderly residents. The two facilities she worked at during the 25 plus years were called Carmel Hall and The Whittier. Callie worked as

a nurses aide until she retired in 2001. Prior to her retiring, Callie joined Peace and Goodwill Baptist Church in the early 1990s; when they were located only a stone's throw away from her home on Conner St.

Upon her retirement, she became a full time homemaker, who cared for her family and anyone who came into her home whether it was for a short stay or a long one. She was always willing to freely give but hardly ever asked for anything in return. Callie was a blessing to so many people.
