Obituary by and for Camille Elonise Williams:

Camille was born on April 1, 1920 in New Orleans, Louisiana; she was raised by Lena and Eugene Jackson (both deceased). At age 3, Camille and family moved to Detroit, Michigan. She was educated in the Detroit Public Schools and soon joined St. Paul A.M.E. under the leadership of the late Rev. Charleston. She was later blessed with a beautiful daughter, Novella, whom she cherished. In 1942, Camille married Frederick F. Wilburn (deceased) and had two sons, Frederick E. (deceased) and Kenneth.

In 1947, Camille moved to River Rouge, Michigan. She soon joined St. John A.M.E. under the leadership of the late Rev. Preston. She worked at Veterans Hospital for 30 years in the food service department before retiring on September 20, 1980. On November 5, 1981 she married Earl Williams and enjoyed memorable, wonderful years before he passed on February 5, 1992 from an extended illness.

Important accomplishments for Camille were: learning to drive and purchasing a new car after age 60; having her first birthday party at age 75 with about 75 in attendance in a large hall given by her children; wonderful marriage to Earl Williams; second birthday celebration with brunch at Hyatt Regency Hotel at age 85 with family and friends; celebrated 94th birthday with dinner at Applebees with her minister, Rev. Daniel Reid, family and friends.

Camille was a wonderful, caring person who loved life and people.
