Mike was rambunctious, tough, quick witted and loved to dress and had an unmistakable swag with an infectious smile that brought joy to everyone around him.

Mike and Myrna met while attending Drew Middle School. After coming into manhood he ran into Myrna again in 1996. On June 12, 1999 they were united in holy matrimony. Mike, who always gave nicknames, affectionately referred to his Myrna as “Woo.”

Mike was a great dancer and an avid sports enthusiast. He would turn a non-sports fanatic into one. He knew statistics of players of several teams and records of teams. His favorite team of all was The Detroit Lions. He loved those Detroit Lions and He was a Lion at heart. One of Mike’s favorite pastimes was watching boxing with his friend/brother Reggie. In addition, Mike gave everyone a special name, “Knee Deep,” “T Love,” “JD”, “M One” just to name a few. Indeed he was a very special man.
