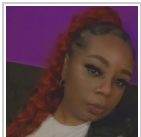

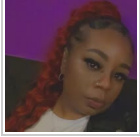

Carol was a beautiful person, who always had a smile on her face. I met Carol in the late 60's, when we started working for BCBSM, we caught the Fenkell bus to work together.

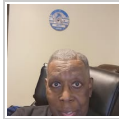
