Carolyn Belinda Luckie was born on April 27, 1949, at Harper Hospital in Detroit, to Grace and Eddie Gamble Jr. (both deceased). She was the fifth eldest of eight children, protecting her siblings at the drop of a hat and was ready to fight anyone that messed with them.

As a young girl, Carolyn was very smart, witty and courageous. She was also very artistic and loved singing, designing and sewing. She would write letters to God asking Him, "Why are we so hungry?" and buried the letters in the backyard. As time moved on, Carolyn didn't care about what she didn't have, because she realized that she had all that she needed.

She graduated from Central High School in 1966 and soon after began taking college courses to learn medical terminology, with the thought of going to Nursing School. However, she landed a job at Michigan Bell Telephone Company, as an Operator. Due to her unique voice, she quickly excelled to the position of "Time Operator." Her family was proud and thrilled to know that it was her voice that people heard when they called to get the time. They would call the phone company several times a day, just to hear her voice.

Carolyn married R.D. Luckie Jr. (deceased) in 1968 and from that union came two sons. She re-dedicated her life to God in May of 1991, joined the church

and attended regularly. Her favorite song was "I am a friend of God."

Carolyn had a big heart and a cheerful spirit. She was loved by virtually everyone she came in contact with and gave her unconditional love and support to others without hesitation. If you needed someone to talk to, she always had an open ear, waiting to listen. She loved children and at some point and time was a babysitter for almost everyone in the family.

Carolyn also loved flowers and Motown golden oldies. Due to her fabulous and flamboyant ways, she was given the nickname "Mama Diva," and she truly lived up to that title.
