Message of Gratitude:

Although his foot rhythmically struck the floor and his body and arms swayed methodically with each phrase of a song, it was on Cecil's face that the choir primarily fixed its gaze. His eyelids were often closed when hearing blissful blending or open wide in disbelief at the sound of dissonant chords. Cecil was the premiere musical director at Elyton Missionary Baptist Church. He controlled a choir's sound and movement as much with facial expressions as he did with his hands.

Cecil connected his faith with music at Elyton for over 47 years. He sang practically all his life, first in middle and high school choirs and later in church and community choirs. He sang with the Donald Vails Choraleers, the Allen Duane Grant Celestial Christian Chorale, and the Thomas Whitefield Company.

Over the years, choirs of various ages and sizes were under Cecil's direction, most notably Elyton's Mass Choir (now known as the Pastor's Chorus) and the Choral Ensemble. Cecil learned to appreciate, direct, and interpret various musical genres, including anthems, cantatas, spirituals, hymns, and both traditional (his personal favorite) and contemporary gospel. While watching him direct a choir, one could sense that Cecil had found his space in the body of Christ and made his horizontal connection with his musical family and a

vertical connection with his God.

To those of you who reached out to us in love, prayers, or any other generosity of time, talent, or resources; we extend our profound appreciation. For those of you who shared his amazing and inspiring journey, we thank you and ask that you continue to perpetuate his legacy of love in your lives and in the lives of all that you touch.
