Charles Thomas "Cholly" Gould was born on July 14, 1946 in Nashville, Tennessee. In 1964, he graduated with honors from Pearl High School, where he was an accomplished musician. Soon after graduating, he, along with his grandmother, mother and two brothers, moved to Detroit, Michigan to take advantage of the many job opportunities available in Michigan at that time. That same year, he began working at Chrysler's Warren Truck Assembly Plant -UAW Local 140 as a relief/repairman. He met his wife of 44 years there. In 1978, he became an apprentice Millwright at Chrysler's Sterling Stamping Plant-UAW Local 1264. In 1981, he graduated his apprenticeship and became a journeyman Millwright where he remained for 28 years.

In 2009, Charles retired from Chrysler after 45 years of service, with a lot of fond memories and good friends with whom he was still close to up to the time of his passing.

The only thing Charles loved, almost as much as his family, was computers. While working at Chrysler, he obtained his certification in Electronics and Computer Repair. Computers were his hobby and his passion. Many people knew him as "the computer guy." Building, repairing, upgrading and programming computers brought him much joy.
