



Mr. Charles James Hazely

July 22, 1934 - May 19, 2014

Charles James Hazely was born in Detroit, Michigan on July 22, 1934 to the union of Wilbert and Susie B. Hazely. He was the youngest of 25 children. Charles grew up in Port Huron, where he attended the Port Huron School District and graduated from Port Huron High School. Here, he played football, and was later inducted into the Port Huron Football Hall of Fame.

In 1956, he enlisted and served in the Armed Forces for two years until he was honorably discharged and earned a Good Conduct Medal. After his discharge from the Army, Charles was hired at General Motors. It was here that he met Lola Porch.

Charles and Lola were married on September 18, 1975 in Detroit, Michigan. He continued to work at General Motors for 24 years and held several jobs over the years until his final job as a Smart city bus driver, where he retired permanently in 2009. In his leisure, Charles enjoyed being around his family and could easily be found in warm weather months gardening and attending to his yard.

After a brief illness at Henry Ford Hospital, Charles Hazely, 79, passed away on May 19, 2014.
