On March 24, 1934, Clarence Eugene Jordan was born in Tenneler, Georgia to Minnie Lee Brown and Clarence Jordan. Clarence eventually relocated to Chicago, where he met and married Rosemary Jackson, and added six children to their union. He later moved to Detroit, Michigan. On April 25, 1982 he give his life to Christ under Bishop Bernard R. McCrary (Pentecostal House of God). He continued to serve until his health began to fail him under Bishop Quintin W. Wingate (Power Hope and Grace Bible Church). Clarence served in Men's Fellowship, Building and Parking Lot Security, Building & Grounds Maintenance and as a Trustee. He later met and married Gwendolyn Parrish who preceded him in death.
