Clarence H. Primm entered this life on December 10, 1938 in Smackover, AR to the union of George and Effie Primm. He was the oldest of four siblings. He graduated from Wallace High School in 1957. At the age of 19, he moved to Detroit and was excited to begin his life in such a fast pace city.

On January 29, 1966 he married Eula Primm (who preceded him in death) and was the father of two children, Richard (who preceded him in death) and Jacqueline. In 1971, he moved to Sumpter Township and later started working for the Sumpter Water Department for 33 years until his retirement.

Following the command of the Holy Spirit, he was directed in 1979 to join Sumpter Community CME Church (which is now called Isom Memorial CME Church) under the late Rev. Lockett Hughes. He served as a member of the Trustee Board while in attendance and went above and beyond when called upon from his church to assist with various programs and functions. He exemplified as a true leader and had no hesitations when doing work for the Lord.

Clarence was also a volunteer firefighter for Sumpter Township. He served the needs of his community by volunteering with the senior citizens.
