Clifford attended Western High School and graduated in 1973. Afterwards, he briefly attended Wayne State University.

In 1977, while working at NBD, he met Annette Marie Finley. They began dating, and a year later they married on July 28, 1979. To that union two children were born, Clifford Cox, II (1981) and LaNette Marie Cox (1982).

Clifford was employed with NBD for 29 years before being severed out. In 2000, he began working for MDS and worked there for ten years.
