“ A Couple of Memories of my Brother Butch:

I am heartbroken that my brother, Clifford (Butch) Snyder is gone, and especially that I am not there to celebrate his life. Butch was and will always be a very special person; he possessed a gifted mechanical mindset. Butch displayed his prowess as early as 4 years old, when he tore off the back of our television set and dismantled every component, in search of the man inside the television.

As a teen, Butch was sent to high school at Detroit City Airport to study aircraft mechanic and from there he became a skilled single engine pilot. One of the most frightening memories I have experienced with Butch was when I was staying in Toronto; he came to take me home for the holidays in a Cessna plane and it began to storm on the way home. We were bouncing around in the sky, so I asked him where were the parachutes. Butch seemed to be entertained to inform me that the FAA only required one for the pilot and that we could not both use it and survive. This nightmare in the sky lead to the next bone chilling experience of learning to sky dive with Butch and purchasing my own parachute.

Butch has always been the consummate adventurer; one to get your heart racing. I pray that God has more wonderful adventures for him in his new life. I love you and will miss you my brother.
