Clifton Walter Divers was born March 22, 1922 to William W. Divers and Anna Jordan in Roanoke, VA. Clifton was 92 years old.

Clifton was the oldest of three children, a brother James Earl Divers (who preceded him in death), a sister Mary Dillard Bolden.

Clifton left Virginia and went to Baltimore, MA. After being there for a few months, Clifton went back to Virginia and got his brother James and took him back to Baltimore to live with him.

Clifton served in WWII and he had an honorable discharge; when he left the service he moved to Detroit.
