June 1, 1946 - October 8, 2014:

Climonteen Hedwood was born June 1, 1946 in Tallulah, Louisiana to the parents of the late Climon and Sallie Mae Nunnery.

Climonteen, affectionately known as Tina, confessed a hope in Christ at an early age. She was a faithful member of Zion Hill Missionary Baptist Church of Clayton, Louisiana where she served as Head Usher. Down South, she never missed a Sunday in church. When she relocated to Detroit, she attended Church of the Living God Temple 69 where she served on the Nurses Board until her health prevented her from attending.

Tina was educated in the Clayton, Louisiana school system and attended Grambling University and Southern University. Because she was such a nurturing person who loved to help everyone, her calling was to work in the medical field. Over the years, she worked as an Emergency Medical Technician and LPN until retirement.

Tina migrated to Detroit, MI in 1964 where she met and later married James Ray Hedwood. To this union three children were born, Monica, Bryant and Derrick. (Her husband James and son Bryant preceded her in death).

Family was the center of Tina's life. She enjoyed spending time with them while playing Bingo, cards and visiting the casino. Tina was a mother to many and touched the lives of everyone she came in contact with. Countless times, she was a matchmaker for her sisters, cousins and friends. With her open door policy, she would take in any family member who needed a place to stay and always made you feel welcome and at home. Her southern hospitality extended to many of Derrick's friends. During Derrick's high school years, she served as a Team Mom for the Pershing High School Football Team and often took in and "adopted" many of Derrick's teammates as her own sons mentoring them along the way.
