Ms. Clondia LueSharon Kirksey the beloved "Beautiful Spirit" was born on April 6, 1950 in Detroit, Michigan to the union of Willie Lee and Lue Vera Kirksey. Clondia was the second child of three children. She was the proud mother of her beautiful daughter Kimberly Kirksey. She was united in holy matrimony to Dezzie Alphonso Knight for 15 years.

Clondia was educated in the Detroit Public Schools and graduated from Mumford High School. She pursued her higher education at Oakland County Community College where she received her Associates degree. Clondia retired from the Wayne County Department of Social Services after 30 plus years of dedicated service in 2002. She was one of the youngest employees in her organization and was promoted to management positions.

She accepted Christ at an early age at New Mount Vernon Missionary Baptist Church under the direction of Pastor R.J. Cunningham. Later she converted to Islam for many years while married.

Clondia "Beautiful Spirit" Kirksey heard the invitation from Martha Jean "The Queen" Steinberg on the radio and received the Holy Inspired Teachings. On February 11, 1989, she became an active member of the Home of Love and

was baptized on August 6, 1989 at Belle Isle Beach. Daughter of Zion Clondia “Beautiful Spirit” Kirksey served faithfully as a member of the Queen’s Community Workers Blessed Prayer Breakfast Dining Room/Kitchen Staff, she also served food to the Joy Building Youth on Sunday, and was a “Divine Lady” Servant. She supported all of the Fund Raising Activities at the Home of Love.

Beautiful Spirit was also a member of the Circles of Light Ministries family for over 16 years and a diligent student of the Institute of Ancient Mysteries class of 2003 for many years and later became a Lifetime member. She deeply loved her Master Teacher Dr. Carolynne “Isis” Fuqua. She was an active member of the F.L.O.W.E.R.S. (Formidable Love of Women Elegantly Revealing Sisterhood) Organization and won best dressed in an annual Fashion show while dressed to the nines in her white with red bling accents.

Beautiful Spirit had a passion for dance and bringing joy to every space she entered.

She was an original member of the Circles of Light Dancing Divas and taught line dance at the Annual conference in Las Vegas for several years. She loved ballroom dancing, Chicago style stepping, and hustle line dancing and was a “regular” at Mr. Loc’s, Fire Water and St. Patrick’s where she traveled “United We Dance” conferences every year. She also volunteered religiously at St. Patrick’s serving senior’s lunch a few times a week. Her love for the arts extended to playing the piano, singing from the heart and acting in “short” films. Her other hobbies were bowling and playing a “master’s level” Bid Whist game.

Beautiful Spirit was well known for her cooking especially her pound cakes, banana pudding, salmon quiche, and vegetable stir fried rice and won several Best Chef awards at the annual Tastefest. She was a world traveler going to places like Egypt, South Africa, Peru, Kenya, cruising throughout the

Caribbean.

Her love of community service led her to serve at the Detroit Rescue Mission, the Children's Center, Forgotten Harvest, Capuchin Kitchen and ongoing at St. Patrick's Food Pantry.

On Saturday, April 21, 2018, Beautiful Spirit said "Yes" and agreed with the Will of the Father to evolve to another plane of life. On Tuesday, April 24, 2018 - 6:50 p.m. at O.H. Pye, III Funeral Home, Beautiful Spirit was Anointed by Fisherman Earl "Doc" Savage during our T.O.F.M. 72 hour observance. Fisherman Earl "Doc" Savage was assisted by Fisherman Robert "Uncle Bob" Martin. Her family members were present at the Anointing. Her name was written in Jesus' Guest Book #298, White and Gold Series, at the Home of Love.
