Clytee Walls Jr. was born to the late Clytee Walls Sr. and Eva Rene Lacy Walls on June 1, 1943 in Memphis, Tennessee. After the sudden illness and death of his mother after childbirth, he was raised by his stepmother Vorida Lee Howard Walls who also preceded him in death along with his brother Ronnie Walls and sister Sharon Pickhens. He was the oldest of six siblings.

On July 1, 1968 Clyde Walls Jr. was united in holy matrimony to Juanita Martin who died April 25, 1983.

Clyde graduated from Inkster High School in 1960. He joined the U.S. Air Force after high school and served four years. He received letters of appreciation and achievement as a dedicated Airman. He also served two years in the U.S. Air Force Reserve at Selfridge Air Force Base in Michigan. He received an honorable discharge certificate in July of 1966 as a testament of his honest and faithful service.

Clyde had a strong work ethic and was employed at General Motors Corporation for 33 years with loyal service and retired in 1998 as Senior Engineering Lab Technician. He was a good man, a faithful husband, and a loving brother. He was kind, caring and helpful. He loved playing cards, spending time with family and was affectionately known by his nickname T-

Bone.

The Lord called Clyde home on February 23, 2015 after prolonged health issues.
