Crystal Star Boone was born on January 13, 1979 to Ormelia and Samuel Boone, both of whom have preceded her in death. She grew up on the Northwest side of Detroit in Michigan on the bustling street of Calvert Avenue (C-Side as it is affectionately called). There she befriended a host of people, many of which she called family. Crystal attended Doty Elementary and Hutchins Middle School. At an early age, she found a love for learning and reading became her hobby. While attending Northern Senior High School, Crystal excelled in many of her classes and often outshining many students in her class. She was a member of several honor clubs, received countless accolades as well as receiving the most college scholarship awards in the city of Detroit in 1997 and graduated as Valedictorian.

After high school, Crystal went on to attend Alabama A&M University in Huntsville, Alabama. Crystal was excited to attend college in Huntsville as it is where both her parents were born and where the majority of her Aunts, Uncles and cousins resided. Crystal flourished in college, participating in various councils, clubs and associations. Crystal was crowned Miss Senior Queen and graduated Cum Laude with an engineering degree in 2001. Crystal started her career early working in a Co-Op program in high school starting out a NBD Bank (currently Chase Bank), as a college student she was an intern for Chrysler. Once Crystal graduated college, she was recruited by IBM and became a Project Manager in North Carolina.

Crystal married her longtime boyfriend Frank Daviston in September 2005 in Detroit, MI. They would divorce many years later.

While living in North Carolina, Crystal was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis.

Deciding she needed to be closer to her family, she returned to Detroit.

Crystal accepted Christ early in life and joined a church home in every city she lived in. When she returned home she made New Prospect Missionary Baptist Church in Detroit, MI her church home. Crystal was called home to the lord on October 17, 2020.
