Cyril joined Detroit World Outreach in 2009, when he relocated to Detroit, Michigan, and under the guidance of Bishop Ben Gibert remained a faithful member of DWO.

Missouri.

Military Experience

He joined the United States Air Force on April 3, 1953, at the age of 20, where he was stationed at Osan Air Force Base, in Seoul, Korea. He served with the 49th Fire Brigade, as a fireman. Cyril was honorably discharged on July 11, 1956. Cyril and his fellow soldiers formed an organization after service called the 46th Veterans Association, with chapters nationwide. The members remained friends and in contact with each other throughout their lives.

Cyril worked as a quality engineer at Forest Park Community College until he retired at the age of 62. Cyril was wed on July 27, 1991, to his beloved wife Barbara J. Huene of Detroit, Michigan. They had a beautiful ceremony in the yard of his new mother, Elizabeth Stovall. They celebrated their 26th wedding anniversary on July 27, 2017.
