Dallas Thomas Barksdale Jr. was born in Lavina, Tennessee to the union of Dallas and Vinnie Barksdale. He was the fourth of nine children. Dallas, also known as D.T., accepted Christ at an early age and became a minister. He baptized his brother, James B. Barksdale. Dallas graduated from Gibson County Training School.

D.T. met his sweetheart, Margaret, and they married in 1942. They moved to Detroit from Milan, Tennessee in 1944. To this union, seven children were born. D.T. worked various jobs throughout his lifetime. He ultimately retired from the Detroit Board of Education.

D.T. was affiliated with Saunders Memorial A.M.E. Church for over 60 years. He loved going to bible study, Sunday school, and singing in the men's choir. He enjoyed reading his bible, poetry, singing, listening to blues and jazz, and spending time with his family.
