Damon Anthony Wilson, Sr. was born in Detroit, Michigan to Harriette Wilson Newkirk on March 6, 1957. The eldest of three children, he maintained a love of God and family throughout his life. As a young man, he gave his life to the Lord and was instrumental in involving his sister and cousins in church youth activities. He was later baptized at the Church of God of Detroit.

Damon attended Central High School where he played football and ran track. After receiving his diploma in 1974, he attended Wayne State University. In 1981, he obtained a B.S. degree in Criminal Justice. Ever mindful of the importance of education, Damon also achieved a certified employment benefits specialist designation in 1995.

He accepted employment with the State of Michigan (SOM) in 1980 and for 18 years Damon held many professional positions.

Damon never missed an opportunity to counsel his family on the importance of planning for the future. He left the SOM as a benefits administrator to join the MESSA as a field representative in 1998 and in 2002 Damon became a regional manager for the Michigan Education Association Financial Services, work he enjoyed immensely and until his untimely departure.

While working for the SOM, he met and married Donna Jean Allen. From this

union, two children were born, Damon Anthony Edward II and Danielle Antonia Je'Naye.

Damon had many interests. He enjoyed playing golf, attending sporting events, traveling, cooking, grilling and acquiring the latest electronic toy. Of all his interests, his greatest joy was his children. Damon devoted much time and energy to their care and upbringing. He enjoyed taking trips with them to enhance their educational experience as well as actively involving himself in their extracurricular activities.

Family meant the world to Damon. He was known to "drop by" and showed up for all family events. He often opened up his home for large gatherings and sponsored trips for his younger cousins. Damon tried to expose them to opportunities that enriched their lives or gave gifts that would do the same. He forged special and loving bonds with so many of his family members.

A favorite saying of Damon's was, "Lord, you will not put more on me than I can bear." After a brief and unexpected illness Damon made his transition on Friday, October 18, 2013.
