One thing to know is, Darrell really knew the ends and outs of downtown Detroit. The action drew him to become a joyful resident in the heart of the D. He was then hired in at a job in downtown Detroit that he really loved. Darrell walked with dignity and pride on this job. Shortly thereafter in 1998, he fell short of an illness.
