When we release our earthly load.*

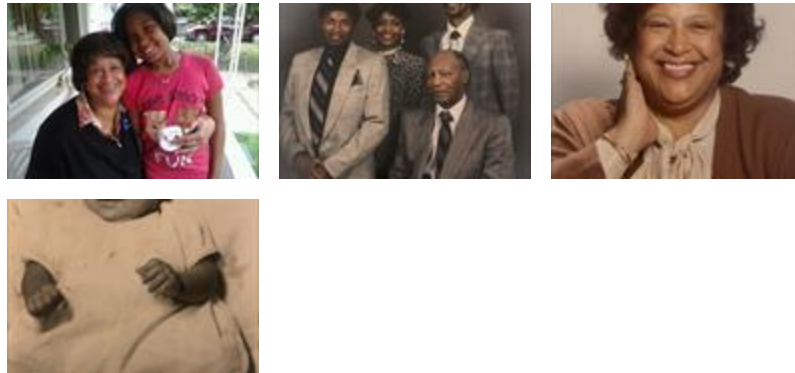
