Mrs. Dorothy May White was born in Lena, Mississippi on September 22, 1938 to the union of Jethro Parrott (deceased) and Essie Lue Ealy (deceased). Her favorite childhood memories were listening to the sound of a train as it traveled on the train tracks near her home.

Mother White accepted Christ as her Savior in her adult years and was baptized at Calvary Church of God in Christ, where she faithfully served over 30 years under the pastorate of the late James E. Slappy, Jr. She served on the usher board with her best friend, Sis. Cannon (deceased), whom she often spoke of and sorely missed. She became a member of Christian Victory Church of God in Christ under Pastor Bruce R. Johnson in her latter years.

She attended Walnut Grove High School in Walnut Grove, Mississippi. For over 54 years, she was a devoted wife and mother to her husband and children. Taking her children to the park was some of her fondest memories. She was a woman of quiet strength who loved reading her Bible and singing hymns and spiritual songs. In addition, she was a very skillful seamstress, a talent greatly utilized in her home, church and community.
