Dwight Edward Nevels, Sr. was the firstborn child to the union of Alpheus Lawrence and Zelma Nevels on January 16, 1933 in Detroit, Michigan. His brothers Lawrence II, Kenneth, Arnold and twin sisters Carol and Kay were his siblings. He accepted Christ at an early age at historical Shiloh Baptist Church in Detroit.

Dwight and Barbara Woods, married in 1951 and to this union eight children were born; Dwight Jr., Elaine, Duane, Dennis, Darris, David, Darryl and Donnis. They also parented a niece Sherry Horston and nephew Rickey Horston who lost their parents in an automobile accident.

Dwight attended Northwestern High School where his talent as an athlete became apparent as a member of the track team there. He was a competitive swimmer and loved playing baseball and ice hockey.

After high school he was employed by General Motors, where he spent his career and became a journeyman. He retired from GM in 1997 after 40 years.

He was a lifelong sports fan, but his talents and interests were diverse. He loved traveling in his motor home with his family and riding his Harley Davidson motorcycle. He served in the USA Army Reserves and was a

volunteer police officer for the Detroit Police Department. He had a natural talent for automobile mechanics which led to another of his hobbies, building and racing cars.

Dwight (better known as "Ike Delight") to his CB buddies and others enjoyed communicating with them daily until his health failed.

Ike was very active in several organizations.
