Earlie Giles was born on July 31, 1948 in Detroit, Michigan to C. L. Giles and Sylesten Johnson Giles. He was the second of three children. Early on in life, Earlie start using the first name as Earl. Earl was first baptized at an early age at St. George Catholic Church. He was later re-baptized at Word of Faith Int'l Christian Center in the early 2000's. He was an active member at Word of Faith going out to minister to local Nursing Homes until his illness.

Earl graduated from Pershing High School and Highland Park Community College with a degree in Drafting Technology. He later attended Lawrence Institute of Technology.

Earl's hobbies included playing the guitar, art, photography, building computers, and he loved playing video games. Earl previously was married to Joann Daniels Giles. They had two children: Nichole Giles Achoe, and Matthew Giles. Earl married Margaret Ball on June 31, 1991. There were no children born between this union.

Earl started working for the Michigan Department of Transportation on February 2, 1969 where he started as a Drafting Technician and completed his career as a Compliance Investigator. He retired on August 30, 2002 after 33 years of service.
