Earma was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Oak Hill, Alabama. In later years, Earma joined St. Philip's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Detroit, Michigan. She was a lifelong member of the Altar Guild, assisted with the youth group and sang in the church choir.

Many a Sunday, you found her in the kitchen of the Fellowship Hall. She loved to serve food and serving was her love.

Earma attended the Alabama Lutheran Academy in Selma, Alabama. She later traveled to Detroit and on October 26, 1957 united in marriage to John Hogue, Sr. John preceded her in death in 1982.

In later years, she became a foster grandparent in a program conducted by the City of Detroit. She received many awards for her years of service.
