November 15, 1929 - February 9, 2014

Mr. Eddie Dee Brooks was the firstborn child of the union of John and Esther Brooks, November 15, 1929, in Kosciusko, Mississippi in Attala County. Eddie's immediate family included eleven brothers and sisters; John "Joe," Katherine "Sister," Pearl Mae, Emma Dee, Wilbert, Mattie, Ruthie Jean, Grace, Annie Ruth, Robert, and Ollie.

Eddie Dee confessed and accepted Christ as his personal savior at a young age and united with Marble Rock MB Church under the leadership of the late Rev. S.L. Brown. He attended Marble Rock County School until the eighth grade. After which, Eddie left home headed to Detroit, MI in 1945 to start a new job. He would keep in constant contact with his parents via US Mail, sending his mother an annual mother's day card.

Due to illness and life circumstances Eddie and his family lost track of one another. But, after years of searching for him he was located and reunited with some of his family. His sister Emma visited him several times in the last couple years, but she passed away on May 7, 2013.
