Devoted Christian, dedicated husband, loving father, brother, son and friend. Edward James Jackson was born on August 13, 1945 to the late Esther Jackson, but was raised by Louis and Sadie Jackson of Carbon Hill, AL.

He accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of First Baptist. He attended and graduated from Dunbar High School in 1964.

Shortly after graduation, Edward was drafted into the United States Navy where he fought in the Vietnam War. In 1969, he relocated to Detroit, MI.

He joined Greater Mt. Tabor Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Rev. Aaron Blackmon. He was a trustee and active in various church activities. He was honorably discharged from the Navy in 1971.
