Elaine Annette Martin was born on November 3, 1958, in Detroit, Michigan to the union of Shelton and the late Vera Martin. She was the second of two girls. At a very early age she was christened in the Spiritual Israel Church and its Army and became an active member in the “Tender Hearts” Choir composed of children who loved to sing. Her love for her church would, years later, become truly evident in the many activities she would participate in church - wide.

Elaine was educated in the Detroit Public Schools and graduated from Cass Technical High with honors. She continued her education at Michigan State University obtaining a Bachelors Degree with a major in Home Economics. Upon graduation, she immediately enrolled at Wayne State University, and graduated with a Masters Degree in Early Childhood Development and Education.

Upon completion of College, she was hired by the Detroit Public Schools and began a teaching career which lasted thirty-three years. Her last ten years she truly experienced the real joy of working with pre-schoolers. Her belief was, similar to her religious teachings, “train a child in the way you would have them go while young, and they will not depart from it”.

During these years of teaching, she met and married the love of her life, Robert Taylor, who was also a member of her church, and had a love for food preparation like herself, and a love for the church. And this love led her to reach out to the many youngsters at church to place their primary focus on higher education after high school.

Elaine, also, had a great love for travel which was evident in the many places she visited during her summer vacations from work. Just to name a few, she traveled to Europe, Hawaii, Jamaica, and extensively within the United States from coast-to-coast. The euphoria of her teen age life was being introduced to Michael Jackson by her cousin Diana Ross in California.

Elaine departed this life on Monday, August 28, 2017 surrounded by family.
