Elizabeth Burt Dillard was born on May 12, 1939 to the late Foster Burt Sr. and Johnnie Lee Burt in Montgomery, Alabama.

Elizabeth accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of Macedonia Baptist Church. After graduating from Booker T. Washington High School in Montgomery, Alabama in 1957, she completed her Associate's Degree from the Floyd Business School as a Clerk Stenographer in 1959. After receiving her Associate's Degree, Elizabeth worked as a Secretary under the team of Charles Langford, a Civil Rights Attorney, as well as undertaking the task of being a notarized official in Montgomery, Alabama.

Elizabeth Burt Dillard and Thomas Frederick Dillard were joined in holy matrimony on June 11, 1961, in Montgomery, Alabama. To this union, two children were born: Frederick Orlando Dillard and Roderick Osmund Dillard.

Soon after marrying, Elizabeth and Thomas Dillard relocated to Chicago, Illinois, and later to Detroit, Michigan where she was employed as a Paraprofessional in both Chicago Public Schools and Detroit Public Schools. Later, she began employment with Henry Ford Hospital as a Dietary/Cafeteria worker and retired after 30 years of service.
