At the age of three, her family moved to Detroit, where she attended and graduated from Detroit Public Schools. She then attended Lewis Business College, where she majored in business. She accepted Christ at an early age and was a devoted Christian. She met and later married Raymond R. Turner, Sr. on September 9, 1942. To that union four children were born.

Eloise was a praying, woman of God, who loved the Lord dearly. She loved her family and had a very giving spirit to everyone, she never met a stranger. She was always praying for someone and her favorite saying was "Lord have mercy, Jesus." She spent her lifetime devoted to her husband and family and was a mother to everyone.
