Emma Jean Teamer was born in Detroit, Michigan on August 19, 1948 to the late Lorene Wooten and Fred Mitchum. Emma accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Oakland Avenue Baptist Church in Detroit, Michigan. Later she joined Liberty Temple Baptist Church where she enjoyed serving on the Women's Auxiliary Board and various other committees.

Emma was educated in the Detroit Public School system, and graduated from Northern High School. She worked for the Michigan Department of Social Services as a Social Worker and retired in 2002 after 32 years of service. Shortly thereafter she opened and operated her own event planning business, Simplicity with Style, which she ran until the onset of her illness.

On February 14, 1968 Emma and Larry Teamer were united in holy matrimony. Their loving union produced two daughters, Yolanda and Krystal. Emma and Larry celebrated 50 years of marriage on Valentine's Day, February 14, 2018.

Emma was a woman of great wisdom, outward and inner beauty, graciousness and a great deal of generosity. She had a great sense of humor and an infectious laugh. She was a strong and independent woman who loved God, family and people. She had a passion for literature, music, shopping and

entertaining family and friends. Emma loved her family and embraced every opportunity she had to be with them. She was someone her family could always count on in a time of need, or just to be someone to talk to. She was a great friend and confidante and she was generous to a fault. Her husband tells the story of coming home one day to find that their brand new kitchen table and chairs were gone because Emma had given them to a family member who needed them.

On October 10, 2018, Emma entered into an eternal rest after a long battle with dementia.
